The Executive Committee of Volt Belgium met on 15 May 2022 in Brussels for a day of teambuilding. Over the course of the day, we agreed on how to work as a team, decided on a shared purpose statement, a long term vision and steps to come up with a strategic masterplan for the 2024 elections.

The shared purpose of the Executive Committee has a **successful election campaign in 2024** at its core. In addition, we want to work on the **professionalisation of Volt Belgium** by improving and empowering internal organisational structures to function autonomously and sustainably. Clear and improved internal communication to and engagement with our members is a key part of that. Furthermore, we want Volt Belgium to **address environmental and sustainability issues** on a policy and on an actions level.

This shared purpose of the Executive Committee also looks beyond the elections of 2024. Professionalising the party will empower us to run a successful election campaign in 2024, but it will not stop there. We want Volt Belgium to lead Belgium and Europe into **a sustainable future that is thought not within electionship cycles but based on a long-term vision**. Volt will position itself as the evidence-based and socially pragmatic green party in Belgium.

The Executive Committee will meet on 11 and 12 June 2022 for a weekend retreat with the leadership of the party to deliver a **strategic masterplan for the 2024 elections**. Together with members of the Provincial Committee, our Functional and Local leads as well as with partners from other Volt chapters, we will create a master plan laying down our goals for the next 6 months, the next year and the next two years.
