Qualifications:

- Affinity with social media and knowledge in publishing in different formats on various channels;
- Research skills on academic and non-academic sources;
- A strategic and results-oriented mindset as well as passion for creating or spotting occasions of synergies with other organizations;
- Ability to scout for good information sources, digest, sum up and simplify complex documents;

- Speaking Italian, as well as having some knowledge of the italian media and politics;
- Ideally, you are nearing the end of your bachelor's degree or pursuing your master's (in the field of political science, law, history, communications, or a similar degree).
- Design and video editing skills;

- **Time:** 40 hours per week, for approximately 6 months;
